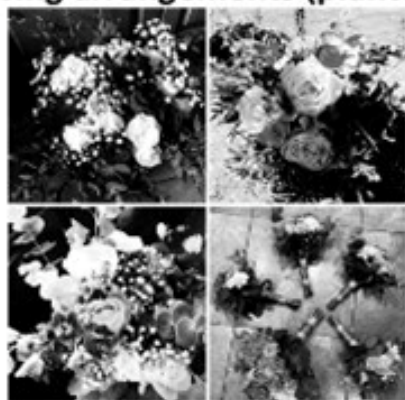


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WELCOME TO THE 2026 LCCP SHOW!

SHOW RULES

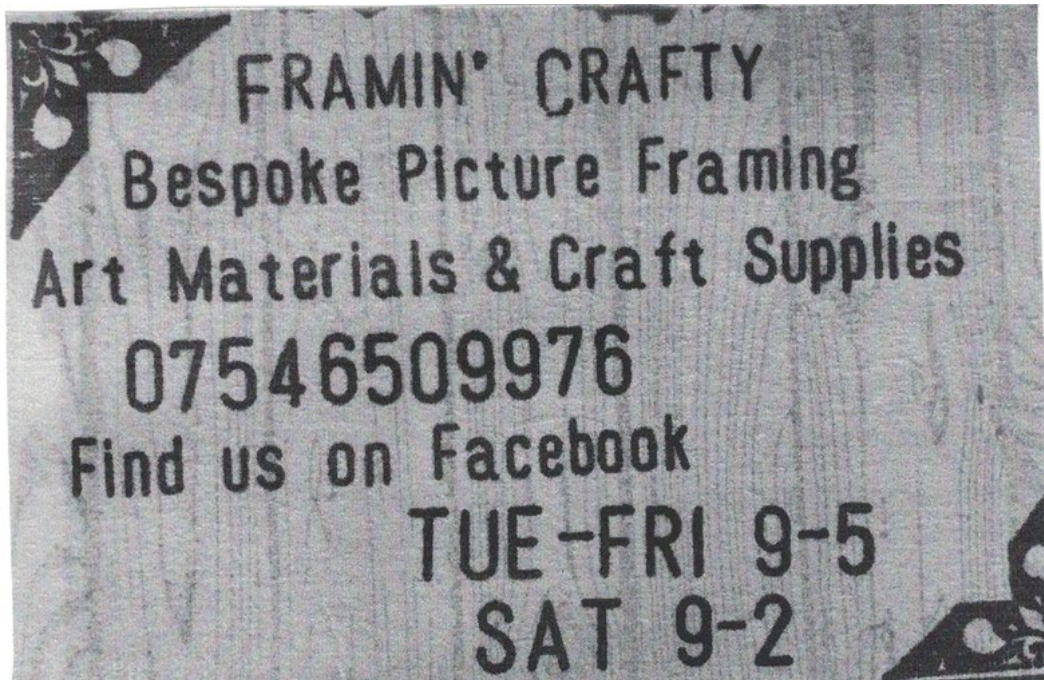
1. All entries must be the property of the Exhibitor in whose name they have been entered and, in the case of Flower, Fruit and Vegetable sections, must be grown on their own property.
2. All Handicraft and Art exhibits must be the sole work of the Exhibitor and not been shown at any previous LCCP show.
3. All Photographs must be the sole work of the Exhibitor and not shown at any previous LCCP show.
4. Marquee entries are to be made on the official entry form that can be found in the schedule or on the website. The form can be posted, emailed or handed to the Entries Secretary on or before the Monday prior to the show.
5. Exhibitors, who are unable to stage their exhibits personally, may forward them to the Entries Secretary who will ensure they are properly staged.
6. All exhibits are to be staged in the Marquee between 0800 and 1000 on Show Day. They should not be removed before 1700 on the same day.
7. The Committee cannot take responsibility for exhibits left in the marquee after 1730.
8. All Exhibitors must leave the Marquee by 1000 unless officially retained by a member of the Committee.
9. Judging in the Marquee commences at 1000. The Judge's decision is final and the right to withhold any award is reserved.
10. Prize money for the Pre-school, Junior and Senior classes shall be paid as follows: 1st – £1.00; 2nd – 75p; 3rd – 50p.
11. Prize monies can be collected from the Treasurer's tent from 1500 on Show Day.
12. Points awarded in all other classes will be 1st – 4 points; 2nd – 2 points; 3rd – 1 point.
13. A NOVICE is an Exhibitor who has not won a 1st Prize at any previous LCCP Show.
14. The Committee shall decide on any matter not provided for in these rules.

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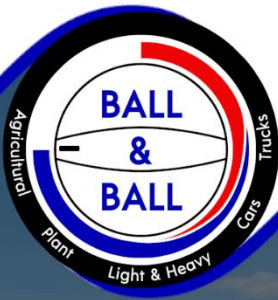

Ingredients

- 225g butter, softened
- 225g caster sugar
- 3 large eggs
- 225g self-raising flour
- 2 tsp baking powder
- 25g ground almonds
- 450g cooking apples, peeled, cored, and chopped, tossed in juice of 1 lemon

Method

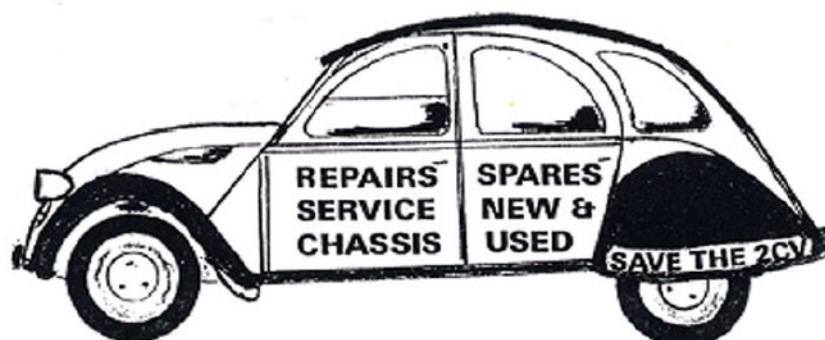
- Preheat the oven to 180/160 fan/gas 4
- Grease a deep 23-24cm cake tin and line the base with baking paper
- Cream together the butter and sugar in a bowl until pale and fluffy
- Add the eggs one at a time
- Sift the remaining flour and baking powder into a bowl, add the almonds and fold into the mixture
- When the mixture is well combined, stir in the apples
- Spoon into the prepared tin, smooth over the top with the back of a spoon
- Bake in the centre of the oven for 50 mins-1 hour, or until a skewer, when inserted into the cake, comes out clean
- Leave the cake to cool in the tin for 10 mins before turning out onto a cooling rack

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72. **Bakewell Tart** (recipe below)

Ingredients

For the shortcrust pastry

- 175g/6oz plain flour
- 75g/2½oz chilled butter
- 2–3 tbsp cold water
- 125g/4½oz caster sugar
- 125g/4½oz ground almonds
- 1 free-range egg, beaten
- ½ tsp almond extract
- 50g/1¾oz flaked almonds

For the filling

- 3–4 tbsp raspberry jam
- 125g/4½oz butter

For the icing

- 80g/2¾oz icing sugar

Method

- To make the pastry, measure the flour into a bowl and rub in the butter with your fingertips until the mixture resembles fine breadcrumbs. Add the water, a little at a time, mixing to form a soft dough (you might not need all the water, only use as much as is necessary to bring the dough together).
- Roll out the dough on a lightly floured work surface to the thickness of a £1 coin. Use the rolling pin to lift the pastry into a 20cm/8in flan tin. Carefully press into the base. Put in the fridge to chill for 30 minutes.
- Preheat the oven to 200C/180C Fan/Gas 6.
- Line the pastry case with baking paper and fill with baking beans. Bake blind for about 15 minutes, then remove the beans and paper and cook for a further 5 minutes to dry out the base. Set aside to cool.
- For the filling, spread the base of the pastry generously with raspberry jam.
- Melt the butter in a saucepan, take off the heat and then stir in the sugar. Add ground almonds, egg and almond extract and stir to combine. Pour into the flan tin and sprinkle over the flaked almonds.
- Bake for about 35 minutes, or until the filling is golden brown and springs back when touched. Check after 20 minutes, if the almonds seem to be browning too quickly, cover the tart loosely with kitchen foil to prevent them burning.
- Meanwhile, put the icing sugar in a bowl with 2½ teaspoons cold water. Stir well then transfer to a piping bag (alternatively just drizzle the icing from a teaspoon).
- Once the tart is cooked and cooled, pipe or drizzle the icing over the top, giving an informal zig zag effect

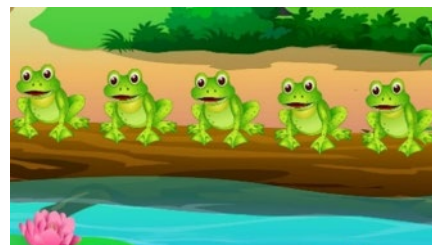

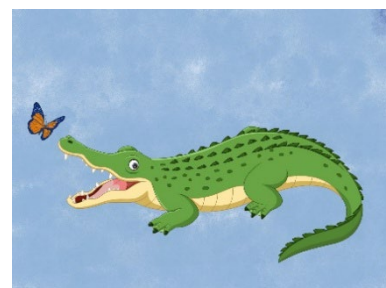

6. Riders must wear protective headgear complying with British Standard PAS 015 (2011) at all times when mounted, including for the fancy dress class.
7. Riders must wear suitable footwear at all times (no trainers).

NO CANTERING OR GALLOPING IS ALLOWED ON ANY PART OF THE SHOW GROUND OUTSIDE OF THE HORSE AND PONY RING. ANYONE DOING THIS WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE SHOW.

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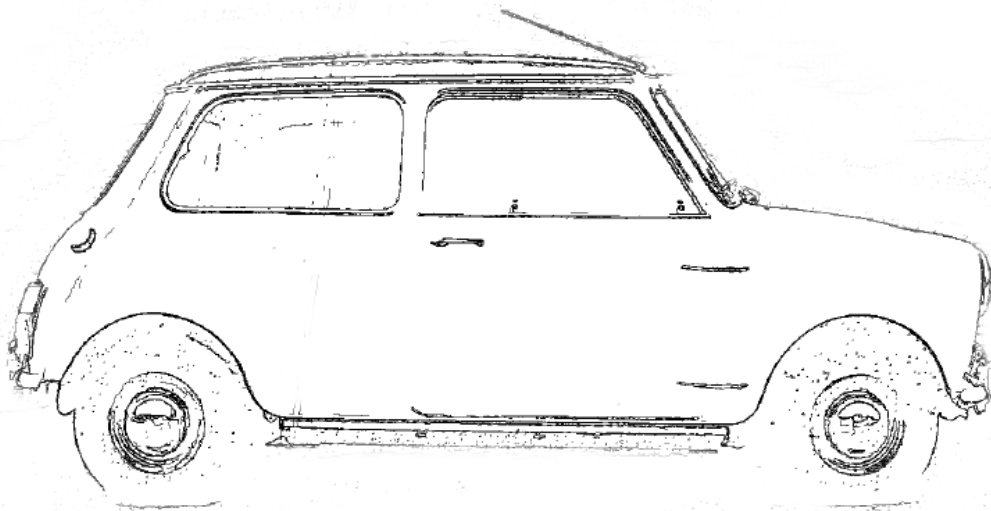
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
